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TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE 2023

These Terms and Conditions of Sale (the “Auction Terms”), and the documents identified herein, constitute the entire terms and conditions with respect to the sale and purchase of wines made available during the Willamette Valley Wineries Association (“WVWA”) The Pinot Noir Auction (the “Auction”). No agent, representative, or employee of WVWA shall have the right to waive or modify any of the Auction Terms set forth herein unless such person is an authorized representative of WVWA. By bidding, whether personally or through a proxy, the bidder agrees to be bound by these Auction Terms. WVWA reserves the right to amend these Auction Terms at any time via addendum or via oral announcements by a WVWA authorized representative during the Auction.

Only licensed members of the trade, their guests, and guests of WVWA, each of whom must be registered in advance, will be allowed admission to the Auction or participate in the Auction. All bidders must be licensed members of the wine trade who have registered as a bidder and received a numbered paddle. The WVWA will provide bidder contact information to Zachys Wine Auctions, Inc. which will operate the sale.

All statements of any nature, whether written or oral, by auctioneer, WVWA, or producing winery about any aspect of the auctioned wines are merely statements of opinion and do not in any way constitute a warranty or representation, either express or implied, concerning the quality of the wine or any other aspect of the wine. Such statements are not to be relied upon by bidders as warranties or representations of fact. Prospective bidders, by so bidding, acknowledge that they have inspected the wines to their satisfaction and bid only on the basis of their own inspection, evaluation and opinion of the wine being sold. All wine is sold “as is” and without any warranty whatsoever, whether express or implied, including, but not limited to, warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

The highest bidder for each wine when the bidding is closed, as determined by the auctioneer, will be recorded as the purchaser of the wine. WVWA will be the seller and retains sole discretion as to when and how to release the wine for delivery to the purchaser. Purchaser has no right to assign or otherwise transfer the right to take possession of the wine to any other party without first obtaining permission of WVWA, who may grant or withhold permission in its sole discretion.

Bids will be accepted only from registered bidders or a bidder’s designated agent and may only be made by numbered paddle issued by WVWA to that bidder. All bidders shall identify the individual(s) that may bid on behalf of the bidder. Such designation shall be made in writing and must be submitted to WVWA no less than 7 days before the date of the Auction. WVWA may rely on the authority of the designated agent(s) to act on behalf of bidder, and bidder shall hold WVWA harmless from any action taken by the designated bidder.

WVWA and the auctioneer shall have the right to reject any bid at any time prior to the fall of the hammer. No bid shall be valid unless acknowledged by the auctioneer. Should a dispute arise between bidders or should the auctioneer doubt the validity of any bid the auctioneer shall have the sole and absolute right to resolve the dispute, re-offer, or withdraw the lot in question.

At the fall of the hammer, the bidder identified by the auctioneer shall be deemed to have purchased the wine and thereupon assumes full risk and responsibility thereof. WVWA shall have the absolute right to withhold release and delivery of the wine to purchaser until purchaser has paid in full. Purchaser’s sole remedy for non-delivery of the wine shall be limited to obtaining a refund of the purchase price.

Bidders and purchasers agree that the sale and delivery of wines via the Auction shall not affect the rights of the producing winery to sell their own wines to any distributor of their choosing or direct to consumers in

bidder’s/purchaser’s state or the right of producing winery to sell wines to any purchaser in said state. Bidder/purchaser agrees to take whatever steps are necessary to protect the rights of the producing winery outlined in this paragraph, including but not limited to the relinquishment of any rights which bidder/purchaser may have under state law. Any offer or sale, as well as any action or proceeding, related to or in connection with the Auction shall be governed by and interpreted under the laws of the State of Oregon. Any offer or sale of wine related to or in connection with the Auction is subject to the provisions of the Oregon Liquor Control Act and Federal Alcohol Administration Act and are offered and sold subject to the provisions of those laws.

ONLINE AUCTIONS

In the event the Auction is conducted wholly or partially online, the Auction will be held subject to the terms and conditions of the host of the online Auction; provided, however, that these Auction Terms control the relationship between WVWA and bidders in the event of any conflicting term of the online Auction host. By participating in the online Auction, bidders agree to be bound by the terms and conditions and other published policies of the online Auction host.

PROXY BIDDING

WVWA may permit a registered bidder to request that a representative of WVWA bid on bidder’s behalf at the Auction. Such appointment shall be made in writing on a form provided by WVWA, and must be submitted to WVWA no less than 7 days before the date of the Auction.

PAYMENT & COLLECTION

Purchaser will submit full payment for all purchases directly to WVWA for each wine upon receipt of invoice. Only one payment per lot is permitted. All bidders must submit credit card information to permit WVWA to charge the bidder’s credit card for wine purchased in accordance with these terms and conditions. By bidding, Purchaser agrees that WVWA may charge purchaser’s credit card for the full amount of the wine for which purchaser was the awarded bidder. Any amount not paid within 15 days of invoice will accrue interest at 1.5% per month. Purchaser authorizes WVWA to charge purchasers credit card for any payment not made within 30 days of invoice.

DELIVERY

All wine is sold FOB the location of the winery that produced the lot purchased. WVWA is not responsible for shipping wine. Shipping or delivery arrangements, expenses and insurance are the sole responsibility of the purchaser. Any shipment of wines out-of-state is the responsibility of the purchaser, who is solely responsible for compliance with the laws and regulations of said state.

MEDIA COVERAGE

As a condition of participating in the Auction, participant permits WVWA to reproduce, adapt, display, publish and distribute, in any and all media whether now known or yet to be developed, any video, photograph, or image taken or recorded of the participant at the Auction, participant’s name, voice, likeness, city or state of residence, and any other information regarding his/her participation in the Auction, and releases WVWA from any liability therefrom.

THE WINE. Nothing that we farm is flat. Great grapes covet optimal exposure, drainage, and elevation. Arcus Vineyard is our most dramatic site, steep, rocky, and home to rich, red, Jory soil. Up there, things are wild and diverse and we farm it accordingly, with zero herbicides and sometimes donning special footwear to navigate the incredible inclines. Ad Alta showcases the very best of this vineyard, made from a unique selection of fruit from the highest-set vines. It's a wine that reflects its unique upbringing, showing tension and rustic qualities. Welcome to the top of the Dundee Hills.

THE WINERY. In 1993, Archery Summit set its sights on creating wines of real purpose in the Willamette Valley. Since, the Dundee Hills winery has helped establish the region as the cradle of cooler-climate American wine. Winemaker Ian Burch and his team achieve bar-raising wines by way of earned instincts—the familiarity gained from many shared vintages, tending sites they know personally. Thirty years on, Archery Summit proudly considers itself the stewards of someplace truly special, with unparalleled potential. The winegrowing stresses organic and biodynamic farming, with zero tolerance for herbicide, nurturing the land and yielding a rousing lineup of estate Pinot Noirs.

THE WINE. We took on farming the Cassin Vineyard a few years ago - converting it to organic practices with the incredible team at Vitis Terra, and these efforts, combined with the great conditions of the 2021 vintage, really helped turn a page for the quality of this special site and the wine we make from it - so much so that it deserved to be commemorated in its own bottling. We put together multiple fermentation lots from this vineyard during harvest, layering in the different clones and adjusting percentages of whole cluster, which has thus allowed us to select from a beautiful range of barrels to blend together for this special Auction Wine. The result represents everything we love about the 2021 vintage: a wine that is powerful, but with finesse and depth.

We named the wine "Renewal" after the 2021 album by bluegrass phenom Billy Strings. The songs featured on the album beautifully address topics like overcoming loss, the anxieties of the current world, and the need for more love and hope. A perfect-fitting soundtrack to the renewal we all felt this past year on earth, and a soundtrack that we hope people can connect with as much as we did.

THE WINERY. Division Winemaking Company is a Portland, Oregon based winery founded in 2010 by winemakers Kate Norris and Thomas Monroe. Division represents a fresh generation of curious winemaking looking beyond the status quo to create unique wines from diverse grape varieties with both purpose and a story.

Determined to make approachable, balanced and affordable wines through minimal intervention, the winemakers work with terroir-expressive vineyards, focused on organic and/or Biodynamic® farming.

THE WINE. This Pinot Noir, coming from the oldest block of Pommard clone in the Résonance Vineyard, is from original un-grafted rootstocks in marine sedimentary soils. This particular bottling is celebrated to be the 40th vintage of this vineyard with the 2021 vintage. Vieilles Vignes is a term in the French language for traditional old vines. This Pinot Noir is full of subtle notes of black licorice, blueberry, violet and spices. The palate is particularly elegant and well balanced between the subtle expression of noble wood from the barrels selected from the Tronçais forest along with the structure from the Résonance Vineyard.

THE WINERY. Thibault Gagey and Jacques Lardière set out to survey an established vineyard named Résonance in 2013. Jacques had led winemaking at Maison Louis Jadot for 42 years, and Thibault, whose family has operated Louis Jadot since 1962, was ready to enter the business. They felt a connection with Résonance. Pierre-Henry Gagey, the President of Louis Jadot and Thibault’s father, agreed. They decided to keep the vineyard’s title, and named their new winery—Louis Jadot’s first outside of Burgundy—in its honor. Résonance evokes great things to come. They added the accent mark to represent this special connection between Oregon and France.

THE WINE. This year we are elated to source our Willamette Auction lot from our new vineyard, Kalita. Situated in the heart of the Yamhill-Carlton AVA, this 22-year-old vineyard has steep slopes of lush, green vines speckled with native crimson clover. South facing with marine sedimentary soils, the wine from this vineyard is weighty, with dark notes of cola, chocolate, and black cherries. This is our first vintage producing a Kalita Vineyard Pinot Noir, and we are thrilled to be able to share it with the Willamette Auction!

THE WINERY. For 50+ years, the Sokol Blosser family has been perfecting Pinot Noir. Now with the second generation at the helm, the winery has entered a new era under the guidance of co-president siblings: winemaker, Alex Sokol Blosser, and CEO, Alison Sokol Blosser. Their focus remains on crafting exemplary wines that reflect the brilliance of the family’s certified organic 89-acre hillside vineyards in the Dundee Hills, as well as exploring the unique terroirs of the Willamette Valley with vineyards in the Eola-Amity Hills and Yamhill-Carlton. A certified B Corp, Sokol Blosser remains committed to an overall sustainable approach.

THE WINE. Primarily from our famed Prince Hill Vineyard, this single-barrel offering was selected from the very best Dundee Hills Pinot Noir we crafted in 2021. Small-batch fermentations allowed us to employ a range of techniques deemed to best suit each vineyard block, broadening the palette we have to select from. We decided on this particular second-filled barrel because of its uniqueness and early approachability, though this wine will also reward cellaring.

THE WINERY. Founded in 1999 by the Duncan Family of Silver Oak, Twomey combines experience and a sense of curiosity with the exploration of unique vineyards for its wines—made to be savored with family and friends. Twomey pursues and sustainably farms vineyards from the Central Coast of California to the Willamette Valley in Oregon that reveal a distinctive character and produce balanced, site-driven wines.

THE WINE. Olson Estate Vineyard, formerly McDaniel Vineyard, was initially planted in 1972 by some of the original Oregon wine industry pioneers. A collaboration based around the friendship of Jim McDaniel, David Lett and Charles Coury resulted in this enchanting vineyard site.

This wine is produced from a compilation of plantings from all seven blocks of Olson Vineyard as a true "Field Blend", producing a complex wine of balance, grace and finesse. Enhanced by the traditional winemaking style of winemaker, Jon Tomaselli, the fruit from all blocks was co-fermented in a 2.5-ton oak upright utilizing 25% whole clusters and then aged for over 16 months in 30% new French oak. It is truly an homage to the legacy of those Oregon industry pioneers.

THE WINERY. Torii Mor Winery was founded in 1993 by Donald Olson, MD, who remains the owner to this day. Since its modest beginnings with just over 1,000 cases, Torii Mor has blossomed into a super-premium winery that focuses on small lots of handcrafted vineyard-designated Pinot noir. Winemaker, Jon Tomaselli is passionately producing world-class Pinot noir in the Dundee Hills of Oregon. THE WINE. Like the small window of time between the chaotic energy of high and low tides, this wine represents the balance of the styles of two winemakers during the transition of their own tides of winemaking influence on the iconic “Revana Vineyard”. THE WINE. Here in lies a story that may not be told! In this steep and rocky block, tasting wine while wilting under an afternoon summer sun, some are rumored to have witnessed an event of near tragic end. THE WINE. *Our Iron Filbert Vineyard is set on a steep southern slope of volcanic soil enhanced with basalt boulders in the heart of the Dundee Hills. The 2021 Willamette Valley Auction Pinot Noir is sourced predominantly from our lower, riper blocks of the estate. We fermented in stainless vessels for an average of 16 days on skins. 10% of the final blend is a whole cluster ferment from the upper Pommard blocks. Once dry, we barreled down to predominantly neutral barrels, with only 5% new French Oak. The wine aged on lees 11 months in barrel, topped weekly.*

THE WINERY. *Marc-André Roy and winemaker Jared Etzel began Domaine Roy & fils in 2012 to continue the winemaking history of their fathers who founded Beaux Frères Winery in 1991. More than 20 years later, we have kept the same focus of producing wine through meticulous and almost obsessive work in the estate vineyards. Stewardship of the land is at the heart of everything we do. We produce timeless wines grounded in the wisdom and traditions passed down between generations of Oregon winemakers.*

THE WINE. *This wine is sourced exclusively from 15 acres of Pinot noir from the first plantings at the Estate Vineyard and a celebration of the winery's 40th anniversary. THE WINE. Our Auction cuvée is once again a blend of Pommard from our estate (70%) and Zenith Vineyard (30%). Our estate component comes from the Pataccoli Family Vineyard, planted in 1978 and own-rooted. The Zenith block comes from 24-year-old-vines on rootstock. This is the fourth year we have blended these two blocks for our Auction cuvée. Typically, these are single-vineyard bottlings. Now that wilderness ain't no place for a greenhorn, but he and that elk became best friends. Little by little Grizzly Adam regained his strength on a special blend of Pinot Noir that combines the raw power of Mount Richmond with the earthy finesse of Five Mountain. Together they became a legend.*

THE WINERY. *One of the founding wineries of the Willamette Valley, family-owned and operated Elk Cove Vineyards was the first vineyard in the Yamhill-Carlton AVA. Adam Campbell is a second-generation owner/winemaker and fifth-generation Oregon farmer specializing in Pinot Noir and cool-climate white wines. Elk Cove selects fruit from their six 100% estate-grown, sustainably farmed vineyard sites located across the northern Willamette Valley.*
